



Register your student(s) online Due: Friday, September 27th	Participation slips must be signed for all students to participate in the Walkathon, even if your child is not walking after school. Please visit Student Participation Slip ptsa.org to register. A paper permission slip is available if that works better for you.	
Volunteer at the event Due: Monday, September 30th	Over 200 volunteers are needed for a successful Walkathon. We are requesting that parents sign-up for at least one shift. Family and friends can also be part of the fun by volunteering and all jobs allow you time to cheer and walk with your student(s).
